

Every year, Dominican High School honors two graduates who exemplify our five core values of Truth, Compassion, Justice, Community, and Partnership. Dominican is pleased to name Annemarie Scobey-Polacheck '86 as the 2025 Distinguished Alum of the Year and Annie Desing '17 as the 2025 Young Alum of the Year.

Annemarie DISTINGUISHED ALUM

This August, Annermarie Scoby-Polacheck '86 was awarded the 2025 Distinguished Alumni Award. A former track and cross-country athlete, Annemarie's dedication to excellence began during her time at Dominican and has continued throughout her life.

Annemarie has served on Dominican's Board of Directors and its Mission and Governance Committee, helping to guide the school's future while remaining deeply rooted in its core values. She is a nationally recognized freelance writer, and has received multiple accolades, including being named a Milwaukee Business Journal Woman of Influence and receiving the Milwaukee Award for Neighborhood Development Innovation.

As the President and CEO of the United Performing

Arts Fund. Annemarie continues to lead with compassion and purpose. She is the author of the heartfelt book, Discovering Motherhood, and helped launch Dominican's KnightRun in 2023, further demonstrating her dedication to the school.

Annemarie is a regular presence at school events—from Alumni Career Day to reunions and benefit parties. As one friend shared, "Annemarie lives her life guided by her faith and truly embodies the core values of Dominican High School in all that she does." A proud Dominican parent, she and her husband have educated all four of their children at the school.



The 2025 Young Alum of the Year Award recipient is Annie Desing '17. Annie spent the five years following her high school graduation as Summer Theatre Camp Director at Dominican, bringing joy and creativity to the same stage where she once performed in 13 shows as a Dominican theatre student. After graduating from Marquette University with a degree in elementary education, Annie began her teaching career at St. Jude in Wauwatosa and now teaches 5th grade at St. Francis of Assisi in Des Moines, Iowa.

She credits her Catholic education as "one of the greatest gifts you can receive," shaping her academically, personally, and spiritually. Reflecting

on her time at Dominican, she shared, "I was surrounded by teachers who made me feel genuinely cared for," and said, "Dominican gave me the confidence to be myself, the joy of lifelong friendships, and the kind of foundation I now try to give my own students." Annie has continued giving back to her alma mater as an Open House tour guide, Career Day speaker, and Auction attendee. Of her time as a theater director, she said, "It never felt like work—we were just sharing what we loved, in a place that felt like home.'

hen Dr. Mary Neuner '84 Caravella reflects on her parents' lives, she describes them as people deeply rooted in faith, family, and education. After the recent passing of their mother, Rita, in May 2025, Mary and her four siblings, Dr. Joan Neuner '86, Jim Neuner, Karen Neuner '90 Hughes, and Tom Neuner '92 found a meaningful way to honor both of their parents'

values. Together they established an endowment at Dominican High School in their late parents' names: The James and Rita Neuner Endowed Scholarship

"Our parents were always intentional about choosing Catholic education for us," Mary shared. "They were deeply invested in Our Lady of Good Hope parish, and Dominican was a natural extension of that community." Both parents believed that high school education should do more than prepare students for college; it should form the whole person. At Dominican, they found

a school that wove faith into academics, fostered curiosity. and offered opportunities in sports, the arts, and leadership beyond the classroom.

Mary recalls how much her parents valued the teachers who fueled their children's intellectual curiosity and the rigor that prepared them for life's next steps. But just as important was the spiritual grounding Dominican provided. Jim and Rita instilled in their children the importance of reflection and prayer, of understanding history and perspectives different from their own, and of acting with compassion for those in need.

Those lessons remain central in the lives of Mary and her siblings today. "Our parents encouraged us to think deeply, to reflect, and to care for others. Those values are woven into who we are today," she said.


> During an interview with Erika LaPean, Director of Advancement at Dominican, Mary said creating an endowment in their parents' honor felt like a natural way to carry those values forward. "It's more than just a one-time gift," Mary explained. "An endowment grows and compounds. It ensures that future generations will benefit from the same kind of Catholic education that shaped us."

> For Mary, the gift was the outcome of valuable discussions with her spouse and siblings about how to be strategic

with their philanthropy. "We hope this encourages other alumni to think about how they can crystallize their philanthropic goals as a family," she said. "Establishing an endowment is a powerful way to honor the people who shaped you."

Through this gift, the Neuner family has created a living legacy that will sustain opportunities for Dominican students for generations to come. It is a tribute not only to their parents' belief in the power of education and faith. but also to the enduring values they passed on to their






2024-2025 INCOME




2024-2025 ANNUAL GIVING

THE CROWLEY LEGACY LIVES ON: HONORING & REMEMBERING ANNE CROWLEY



Dominican High School honors the life of Anne Crowley, who passed away on November 20, 2024. For more than 65 years, the Crowley family has been at the very heart of Dominican, sending four children through our halls, while Anne and her husband, Bill, devoted countless hours of service to the school they loved. If you have ever stepped foot inside Dominican, you know the Crowley name—after all, it's written proudly across the gymnasium floor.

Anne's devotion to family was matched by her commitment to the Dominican community. She supported Bill's storied coaching career, spent a decade shaping young minds in the school library (occasionally overlooking an overdue fine or two), and touched the lives of countless students.

But Anne's impact extended far beyond titles and roles. She wasn't just a mother, —she was Mom to everyone. Whether she was sewing costumes for school plays, baking something unforgettable, or offering the kind of knowing look that could stop a teenager in their tracks, Anne had a gift for making each person feel seen, valued, and loved.

In the days following her passing, friends and family came together to honor Anne with memorial gifts to Dominican. Their generosity raised \$13,000 for the Crowley Scholarship Fund, ensuring that Anne's legacy of kindness, faith, and love will continue to shape the lives of future Dominican students for generations to come.


